Retail Sales	8.6	per hour	Participants will be working in our gift shops or candy stores located throughout the boardwalk. Jobs duties will include assisting customers, managers, and fellow employees. Stock shelves, help moving merchandise, and making sure the store is clean. Employees will be vacuuming and straightening up if the store is slow. These jobs do pay overtime after 40 hours and employees are typically scheduled between 35-40 hours a week. Employees working in a candy store can receive tips, gift shops do not.	No	No
Ride Operator	8.75	per hour	Ride operators will operate one of our 26 rides and assist customers onto the ride, making sure riders are restrained properly and answer any questions they may have about our facilities. This job is exempt by law and does NOT pay overtime rate. Employees will work in excess of 50 hours per week. Our ride park opens at noon everyday between Memorial Day and Labor Day weather permitting. Employees must wear sneakers and brown/khaki pants/shorts. There is absolutely no cell phone use while on ride.	No	No
Game Operator	8.6	per hour	Employees will be working the games stands located throughout our property. Employees will try to draw in customers to play the games which range from shooting games to spinning a wheel, the winners will receive prizes.
